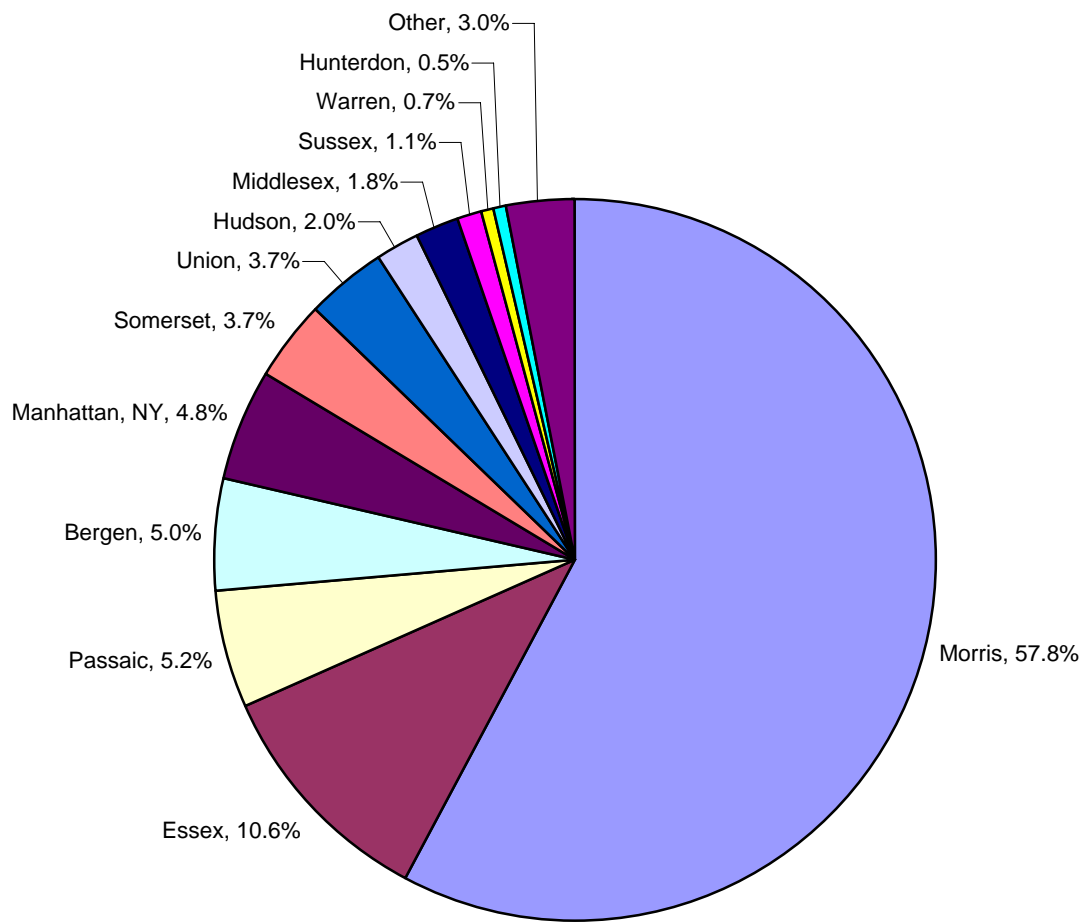

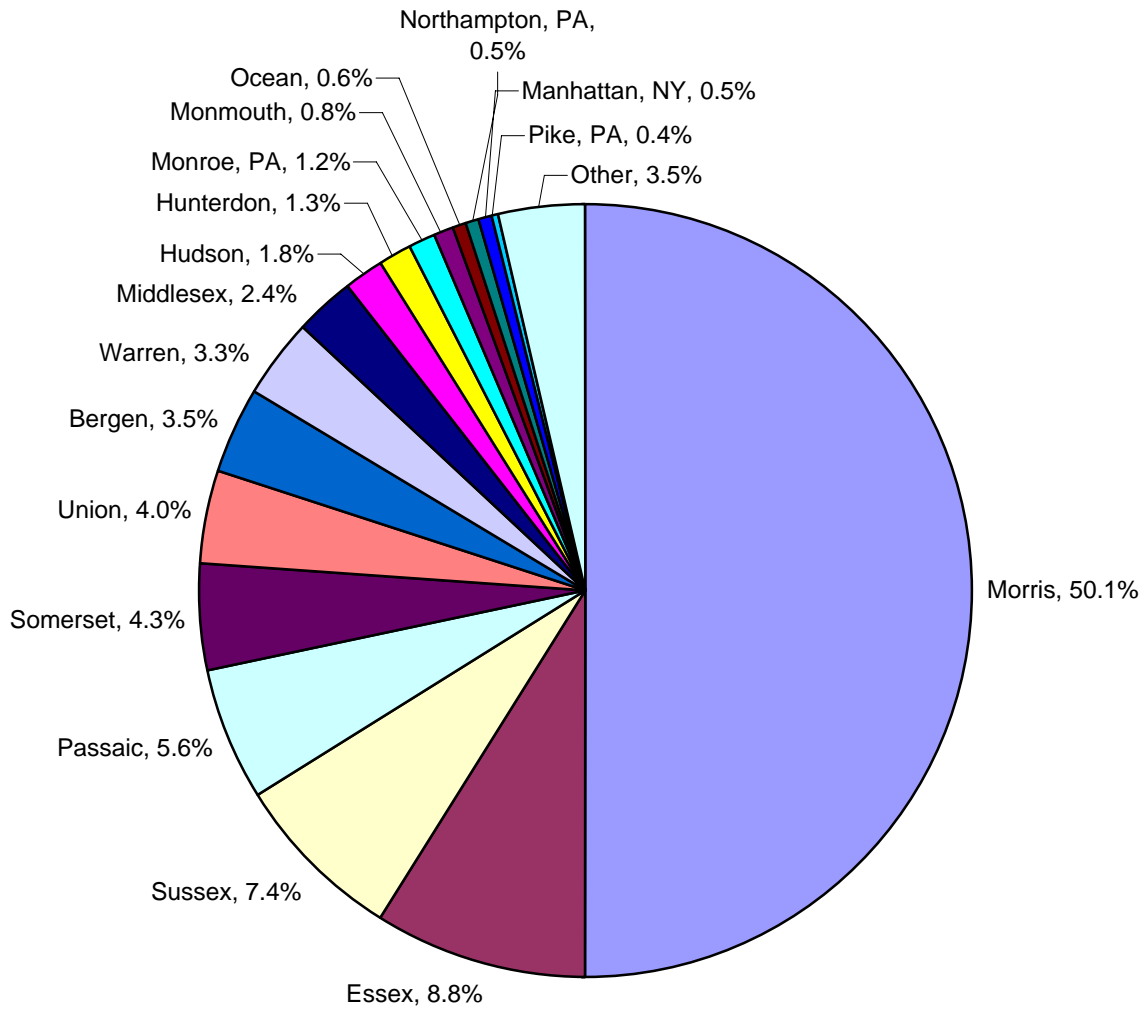
# Morris County Residents' Place of Employment

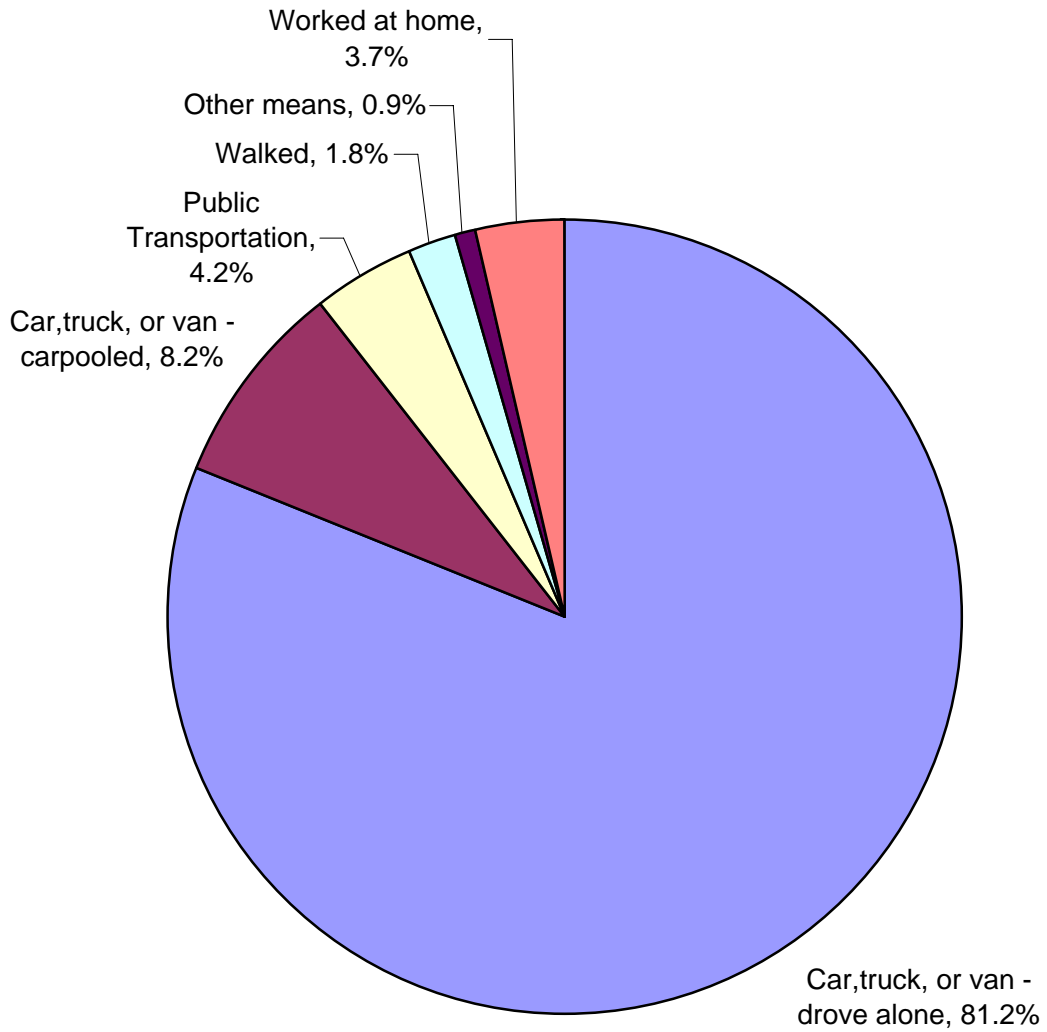

## Means of Transportation to Work, Morris County, 2000



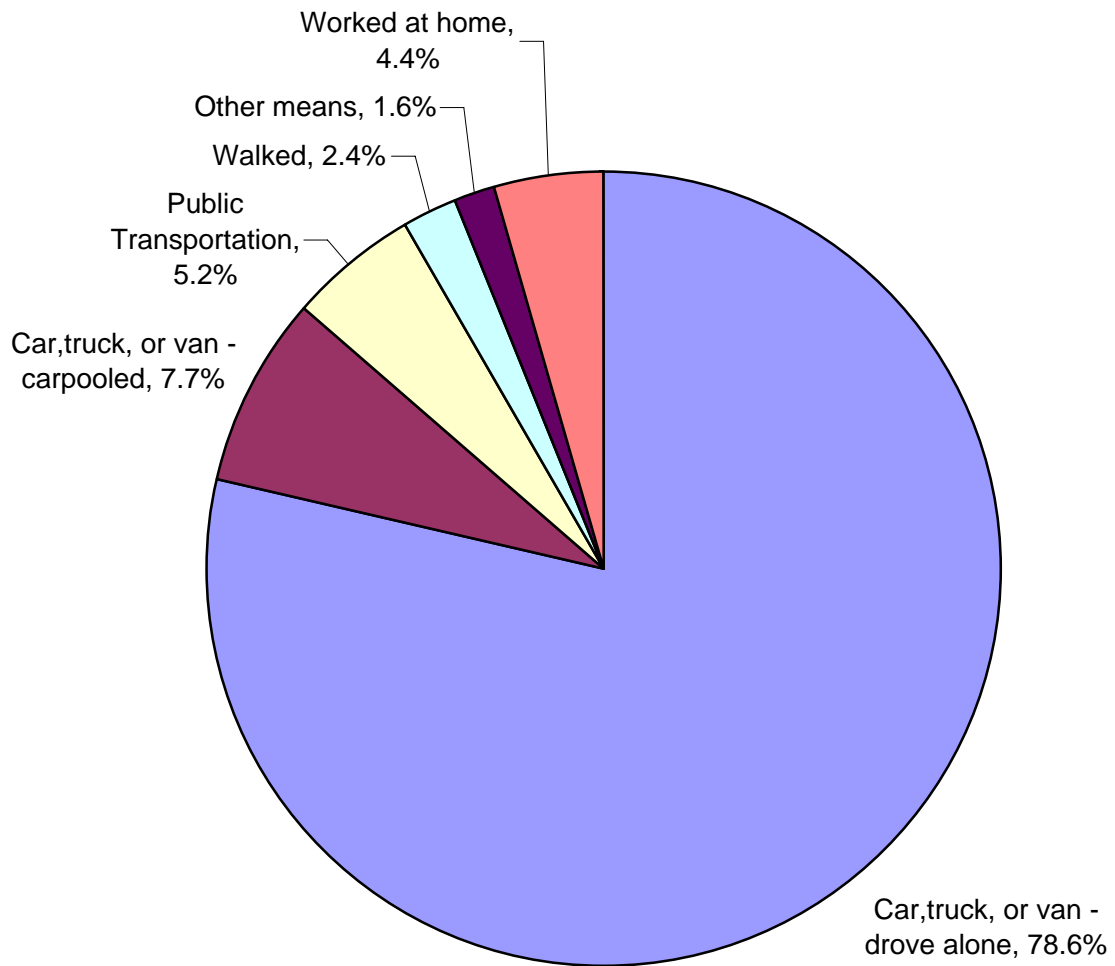
